God's Word is changing the lives of soldiers in Ukraine. With your help, Canadian Bible Society has been making the Bible available to soldiers as well as civilians in Ukraine since the war broke out.

Serhii, the commander of a military unit, shares, "It is very important for soldiers to have the Bible. Things are very tough at times and many soldiers are praying to God. They may not have believed in God before. But now they are turning to Him. Many of them treat the Bible as a lifesaver.

"So, for those facing enormous pressures on the frontlines, when they have this Bible in their pocket, a soldier can open it and find words that he needs to hear at that very moment. It is very important. Thank you!"

Another soldier turns to open his Bible when he faces desperate situations. "You wouldn't believe it," he says. "Every time I find an answer. The Bible has a way out! I do as the Bible says and everything works well."

Winnipeg's North End is home to many families who struggle with poverty. Young people in the neighbourhood face the constant lure of gangs and drugs. And it's in this neighbourhood that Inner City Youth Alive (ICYA) has been working for nearly 35 years.

With your support, Canadian Bible Society has provided Bibles and Scripture resources that are making a difference for young people in Winnipeg.

One of those young people is Terry, who first came to ICYA when he was 13. He came from a difficult family situation filled with abuse, neglect, violence, drugs, and alcohol. Some days he would even bring a weapon to the youth meetings.

The staff at ICYA built a strong relationship with Terry, sharing God's Word and the love of Christ with him. Today, Terry is a young man of God, a loving husband and father to a little girl, and a compassionate leader serving here at ICYA. He is working to show God's redeeming love to other Indigenous youth here in Manitoba.

Life in many parts of the Middle East is not easy for women. The local culture often leaves very limited space for women to contribute to society outside their homes. A woman is expected to clean, cook, and raise the children by herself.



Estimates by the World Health Organization indicate that about 30% of women worldwide have been subjected to violence in their lifetime.¹

The Bible presents a different and more robust picture of what a woman can be — and what God created women to be. God's Word shows women they are made in the image of a God who loves and cherishes them. The Bible's message gives dignity to women.

That is why you can have such a dramatic impact on the lives of women by helping provide them with Bibles along with the support of other women in Bible studies. Farah, a woman who lives in Arab Israel, recently discovered this hope.

"When I read the Bible I see love," says Farah. "And I've learned that God loves me for who I am."

After ten years of marriage, Ayuba was weary and depressed. His once joyful home had become full of quarrels, misunderstandings, and disappointments. Without a job, he could no longer

provide for his family like he used to. He felt crushed by his wife's demands for things he could not afford, and grew more ashamed, frustrated, and isolated as the days wore on.

Ayuba even entertained the thought of leaving his family for good, until he listened to the weekly Bible-based Trauma Healing session on the radio.

The Bible-based curriculum for groups includes sessions that help participants identify their pain, share their suffering, bring their pain to the cross of Christ for healing, and, for cases where the trauma was caused by the actions of another person, learn to forgive their oppressors.

Since attending Bible-based Trauma Healing, Ayuba and his wife have forgiven one another. Thanks to generous Canadian donors, Ayuba no longer thinks about leaving his family, and is instead grateful for them and their restored relationship.


